

Here are some more details about our workshare program.

1. Workshares work for 20 weeks, 4 hours a week in exchange for a Summer/Fall share.
2. The day and times you work every week are the same, once you pick a time slot you are locked into it for the entire season. We have the following time slots available:
Monday 8AM-Noon, Tuesday 8AM-Noon, **OR** Thursday 8AM-Noon.
3. You must be available one of these time slots, we are not able to accommodate any other days or times.
4. We treat this as a serious commitment because we rely on our workshares to complete many time sensitive tasks.
5. The 20 weeks run consecutively beginning the week of April 29th and the last being the week of September 9th.
6. We realize many people take trips during the summer months. A week or two can be missed for these scheduled events as long as we are told at least 2 weeks in advance and the weeks are made up by adding them to the end of your time.
7. Sending someone in your place is not allowed. You may not bring anyone with you during your workshare time.
8. After 2 absences or late arrivals your workshare position will be terminated.
9. All the work we do is manual labor. It involves bending, kneeling and lifting on average 30 pounds but can be as high as 50 pounds on rare occasions. If you have a bad back or knees this is not for you.
10. We work in all weather and it is your responsibility to bring appropriate attire (rain gear, boots, sun hat, sunscreen, gloves etc.)
11. Children (anyone under 18) are never allowed on the farm during the work week for safety reasons.
12. No experience is necessary just enthusiasm and a willingness to work hard and learn. Typically you will spend most of your time weeding. Other tasks including harvesting and planting might be done occasionally.
13. Dave or Sara will always be on site and often working along side the workshares. We use this time to help guide the work and answer questions. We think farming work can be interesting, educational and fun.
